

### Day 1: Noboribetsu Onsen & Lake Toya

- Pick-up in Sapporo** Your guide will be waiting at 8:30am at the lobby of your hotel; **please confirm your hotel details**
- Drive to Noboribetsu Onsen** Estimated driving time is approx. 1 hr. 45 min.
- Noboribetsu Hell Valley & Geothermal Sightseeing** Explore the geothermal spots of Noboribetsu by foot or car, such as the 450m long Hell Valley, the huge Oyunuma hot springs lake, river and waterfalls, and have a foot bath in the middle of the forest
- Orofuretoge Mountain Pass Scenic Drive** Panoramic views of the Central Mountain Range, including Mt. Yotei, the "Fuji of the North"
- Lunch at Lake Toya** Recommended: Wakasaimo with lake views and quality Japanese cuisine

#### Lake Hill Farm & Silo Observatory

Famous gelato with great countryside views, followed by the iconic Lake Toya caldera rim viewpoint at Silo Observatory

#### Mt. Usu-zan Ropeway & Crater Rim Walk

Ride the ropeway, then walk along the crater rim of Hokkaido's most active volcano for great views of Mt. Yotei, Mt. Showa-Shinzan, Lake Toya & the Pacific Ocean; extended hiking options available

#### Kompirayama Trail of Destruction

The trail passes ruins where you'll see the destructive power of volcanos by observing the damage that was inflicted from the most recent eruption in 2000

#### Hotel Check-in, Onsen & Dinner

Lake Toya is the deepest lake in Hokkaido. We'll try to reserve lake view rooms from where to watch the nightly fireworks show starting at 8:45pm

#### Overnight: Lake Toya (dinner & breakfast included)



### Day 2: Lake Onuma & Hakodate

#### Drive to Onuma National Park

Estimated driving time is approx. 2 hrs.

#### Onuma Lake Islets Nature Walk

Walk among the hundreds of islets at this small lake, which is crowned by an attractive volcano, while enjoying the cherry blossoms

#### Drive to Hakodate

Estimated driving time is approx. 45 min.

#### Konbukan Kelp Factory

Tour this seaweed factory and sample the endless variety of seaweed products

#### Lunch in Hakodate

Choose from a variety of great restaurants, including Lucky Pierrot Hamburgers, a nationally-famous hamburger chain with restaurants only in Hakodate

#### Goryokaku Tower & Fort

Visit the last fort built in Japan in order to repel a Russian invasion; the 5-star design, motes and park are at their best during the incredible sakura month, when

Recommended Months: mid/late April to early June

- over 2,000 sakura trees bloom at once. Then, ride to the top of the tower for excellent views and historical overviews of the city
- Motomachi Historical District** Tour Hokkaido's best colonial-era town while admiring the serene port views below
- Hakodate Ropeway & Nightview** Ride the ropeway to see the famed night views of Hakodate Bay, rated the 3<sup>rd</sup> best night view in Japan
- Dinner in Hakodate** Choose from a variety of great local restaurants, including seafood and wagyu recommendations
- Hotel Check-in, Onsen** Hakodate is Hokkaido's best colonial era city, with a historically international presence and top sightseeing
- Overnight: Hakodate Yunokawa Onsen** (breakfast included)



## Day 3: Hakodate & Matsumae

- Hakodate Asaichi Morning Market** Stroll among the more than 300 seafood stalls in Hokkaido's most famous morning market, with a chance to go squid fishing inside the market!
- Drive to Matsumae** Estimated driving time is approx. 2 hrs.
- Matsumae Sakura Festival** This superb cherry blossom festival has over 250 varieties of cherries spread across 10,000 trees, set along the grounds of Hokkaido's only castle, a few temples and an easy viewpoint walk
- Lunch in Matsumae** Choose from a variety of local restaurants
- Matsumae Yashiki Clan Mansion** At this historical theme park, you can rent Edo period costumes and have your photos taken, participate in a traditional cooking workshop, or simply stroll the grounds to see the representative village (DIY activities are self-pay; reservations required)

- Dinner in Hakodate** Choose from a variety of great local restaurants, including seafood and wagyu recommendations
- Hakodate Bay Cruise** Take in the atmosphere of Hakodate Bay on a 1-hour cruise, see the iconic Red Brick Warehouses and other historical buildings on the placid waters of the bay
- Return to Hotel & Onsen** Enjoy a 2<sup>nd</sup> night at Hakodate Yunokawa Onsen
- Overnight: Same as Day 2** (breakfast included)



## Day 4: Kyogoku & Niseko

- Drive to Kyogoku** Estimated driving time is approx. 3 hrs.
- Kyogoku Freshwater Spring** Bring your water bottles to fill-up at this revered local spring
- Drive to Niseko** Estimated driving time is approx. 30 min.
- Lunch in Niseko** Choose from a variety of local & international restaurants
- Niseko Skyline Scenic Drive** Drive up a winding mountain road to the geothermally active highland plateau behind Niseko, with a chance to visit a hot springs lake and river, as well as great views
- Niseko Highland Marsh Walk** Take a short hike on boardwalks through a highland marsh in the mountain behind Niseko
- Yumoto Onsen & Hot Springs Lake** Take a relaxing onsen at this voluminous hot spring with numerous outdoor pools and even a mud bath

**Hotel Check-in & Dinner**

Niseko is a popular winter resort surrounded by nature that is more peaceful in the summer offseason

Recommended: Fuji Sushi for fantastic seafood and a varied menu; Jun’s Seafood Restaurant for a Mom-n-Pop style restaurant with large portions & good prices

**Shakotan’s Ebisu-Iwa & Daikaku-Iwa Rocks**

These *Shintai* rocks – or physical entities that harbor spiritual beings – represent the gods Ebisu (fishermen) and Daikaku (wealth), and lie in a tranquil spot off the Shakotan coast

**Drive to Yoichi**

Estimated driving time is approx. 45 min.

**Nikka Whisky Distillery**

Tour the beautiful distillery grounds and learn about the history of Hokkaido’s most famous whisky brand; samples & purchases available

**Otaru Sakaimachi Historical District & Otaru Canal**
