Day 1: Higashikawa & Asahidake Onsen

Pick-up in Sapporo	Your guide will be waiting at the lobby of your hotel at 8:30am; please confirm your hotel details
Drive to Higashikawa	Estimated driving time is approx. 2 hrs. 30 min.
Higashikawa Craft Sites	The town of Higashikawa outside Asahikawa is famous as a handicraft village, especially in pottery, woodwork & photography, with a burgeoning café scene as well
Lunch in Higashikawa	Choose from a wide variety of small restaurants, many with original twists on classic Japanese staples including soba, udon, ramen & more
Asahidake Freshwater Spring	Fill up your water bottles at this spring known for its pure tasting water

Asahidake Ropeway & Sugatami Highland Plateau Snowshoeing

Ride the ropeway high above the snowy forests and go snowshoeing across the remarkable Sugatami Plateau at the base of Mt. Asahidake, Hokkaido's highest mountain, to reach the steaming fumaroles at the foot of the mountain

Hotel Check-in, Onsen & Dinner

Asahidake Resort is nestled at the base of Mt. Asahidake, Hokkaido's highest mountain

Overnight: Asahidake Onsen (dinner & breakfast included)



Day 2: Tenninkyo Gorge, Souunkyo Gorge, Cape Notoro & Abashiri

Tenninkyo Gorge & Hagoromo Falls Snowshoeing

Explore the neglected Tenninkyo Gorge with its columnar joint cliffs, waterfalls and an easy snowshoeing nature trail to the frozen Hagoromo (Angel Dance) Falls, which at 270m is Hokkaido's highest waterfall

Drive to Souunkyo

Estimated driving time is approx. 1.5 hrs.

Lunch at Souunkyo Onsen

Recommended: Beer Grill Canyon for Italian Japanese fusion with a focus on locally sourced ingredients

Souunkyo Gorge 8 Frozen Waterfalls Snowshoeing Trail

Beginner-level snowshoeing along the frozen Souunkyo Gorge, spotting frozen waterfalls, Ezo-deer, eagles and other wildlife in the best gorge in Hokkaido

Drive to Abashiri

Estimated driving time is approx. 3 hrs.

Cape Notoro Sightseeing

A classic cape with a lighthouse, with panoramic views of the Sea of Okhotsk

Hotel Check-in, Onsen & Dinner

One of Hokkaido's most remote destinations, Abashiri is on the Sea of Okhotsk and is surrounded by lakes

Overnight: Abashiri (dinner & breakfast included)

Day 3: Abashiri, Utoro & Rausu

Abashiri Prison Museum
OR
Okhotsk Ryuhyo Museum

The most feared prison in all of Japan during the Meiji Restoration Period – we'll see the living conditions that prisoners persevered through;

OR
Learn all about drift ice at this modern museum in eastern Hokkaido, the southernmost place on earth with drift ice

Utoro Scenic Drive & Waterfalls

Enjoy a coastal drive to Utoro, with tall cliffs & plunging waterfalls along the seaside road

Shiretoko UNESCO Conservation Center & Local Products Market

Be introduced to the many faces of Shiretoko Peninsula, with a fascinating 20 minute movie about the flora & fauna at Hokkaido's only UNESCO World Heritage site, then check out local products at the adjoining Michi-no-Eki (local products market)

Lunch in Utoro

Famed for fresh seafood from its legendary waters, Utoro is the place to try a variety of top seafood items

Drive to Rausu

Estimated driving time is approx. 2 hrs.

Rausu Fishing Villages Scenic Drive

Drive along the famed Rausu coastline, passing remote fishing villages and stunning seascapes

Hotel Check-in, Onsen & Dinner

Rausu, famed for seafood, wildlife & hot springs, is located within the UNESCO World Heritage Shiretoko Peninsula

Overnight: Rausu (dinner & breakfast included)



Day 4: Rausu, Notsuke Peninsula & Yoroushi Onsen

Rausu Winter Nature Cruise

Cruise through the waters off Rausu, in search of drift ice, Steller Sea Eagles and other sea life

Rausu Local Products Market & Lunch

Check out the variety of local marine products, such as kelp, crab, uni and salmon, then enjoy lunch upstairs where seafood is the specialty

Drive to Notsuke Peninsula

Estimated driving time is approx. 1 hr. 45 min.

Notsuke Peninsula Wildlife Spotting

This sand spit peninsula becomes a wildlife refuge in winter, with scores of deer, Hokkaido Red Fox & Steller's Sea Eagles

Drive to Yoroushi Onsen

Estimated driving time is approx. 1 hr. 15 min.

Ryokan Check-in, Onsen & Dinner

A unique experience in staying at one of Hokkaido's best traditional Japanese ryokans with a chance to spot the rare Blakiston's Fish Owl & Japanese sable

Overnight: Yoroushi Onsen Yuyado Dai-Ichi Ryokan or similar (kaiseki dinner & breakfast included)

Day 5: Lake Mashu, Mt. Iou, Lake Kussharo & Tsurui Village

Lake Mashu Sightseeing & Crater Rim Snowshoeing

From the viewpoint of Lake Mashu - a conical volcanic lake rated among the world's clearest waters - we'll go on an easy snowshoe hike along the crater rim for more incredible views and wildlife spotting

Lunch in Teshikaga Mt. Iou Geothermal Park

Recommended: Teshikaga ramen, the local specialty
Experience the active volcanic area of Mt. Iou, where sulfur vents billow from the ground

Lake Kussharo Sunayu & Kotan Wild Onsen

Take a foot bath at this unique beach onsen, where onsen water rises up as you dig a hole in the sand; nearby is Kotan no Yu Wild Onsen, dramatically located on the shores of Lake Kussharo (separated bathing areas for men & women with basic changing facilities; bathing suits permitted; bring your own towels); these are also winter nesting spots for whooper swans & Mallard ducks, and visitors can walk right up to the birds!

Drive to Tsurui Village

Estimated driving time is approx. 1 hr.

Hotel Check-in, Onsen & Dinner

Tsurui Village is one of Japan's most famous villages, mainly because of the successful efforts of the locals in saving the tancho cranes from extinction

Overnight: Tsurui Village (dinner & breakfast included)



Day 6: Kushiro Marshland & Tsurui Village

Kushiro Marshland Canoeing

Go on a 1- hour canoe ride surrounded by the frozen marshland in Japan's largest marsh, observing a variety of wildlife & birds with a professional river guide

Kushiro Marshland Observatory

Take in the wide panoramic views of Japan's largest protected marshland, a chance to spot wildlife such as the iconic Tancho cranes

Kushiro Washo Market & Lunch

Sample some of the freshest seafood in Hokkaido, with a huge variety of sashimi that you can choose per slice directly from the vendors, or choose from a variety of other seafood dishes

Akan International Crane Center

The top site for crane watching, with the open fields and mountain vistas perfect for photography; a short and informative documentary about the dramatic history of near extinction and yearly life cycle of the cranes, along with English subtitles, is also available

Tsurui Village Crane Spotting

Drive through the village where crane feeding started over 70 years ago in one of the best conservation efforts in Japan's history; today we can often spot the Tancho red-crowned cranes grazing in the fields and roosting in the waterways outside the village

Return to Hotel & Dinner

Enjoy a 2nd night in Tsurui

Overnight: Same as Day 5 (dinner & breakfast included)

Day 7: Shikaoi, Obihiro & Sapporo

- Drive to Shikaoi** Estimated driving time is approx. 2 hrs. 15 min.
- Dogsledding at Shikaoi** Get pulled by a team of dogs on a 10 kilometer trail while a lead snowmobile gets perfect shots of you as a musher; full instruction, guiding and safety briefing included
- Drive to Obihiro** Estimated driving time is approx. 30 min.
- Lunch in Obihiro** Obihiro is famous for butadon, or braised pork on rice, owing to the many pig farms in the Tokachi region
- Ryugetsu Sweetpia Garden** See the factory production line at this famous dessert house, then sample & purchase sweets in the gift shop
- Drive to Sapporo** Estimated driving time is approx. 3 hrs.
- Drop-off in Sapporo** Unfortunately, this marks the end of our tour together . . . until next time!
