Name: Sakhalin/Glehn's Spruce (*Aka Ezomatsu*)

Type: Evergreen Conifer

Bark: Dark brown

Size: Height 40m / Circumference 1m

Where in Hokkaido: Eastern & Northern regions

Interesting Fact: Flowers blooms on the top part only so they're difficult to see



Name: Japanese Oak / Quercus Crispula Blume (*Mizunara*)

Type: Deciduous

Bark: Dark brown

Size: Height 25-35m / Circumference 1.5m

Interesting Fact: Used for barrels for aging Japanese whiskey



Name: Monarch Birch (*Udaikaba*)

Type: Deciduous

Bark: Flaking gray

Size: Height 25-30m / Circumference 1m

Interesting Fact: Contains oil, burns easily, valuable as timber & plywood



Name: Linden / Japanese Lime / Tilia Japonica Simonkai (*Shinanoki*)



Name: Manchurian Ash (Yachidamo)



Name: Manchurian Elm / Cut-leaf Elm / Lobed Elm (Ohyu)

Type: Deciduous Bark: Light brown

Size: Height 25m / Circumference 1m

Where in Hokkaido: All regions

Interesting Fact: Bark is anti-inflammatory, can be used as incense & fibers, wood used in construction



Name: Japanese Yew (*Ichii*)

Type: Evergreen Conifer

Bark: Reddish brown

Size: Height 5-15m

Where in Hokkaido: All regions

Interesting Fact: Ainu used in making arrows & for woodcarving









Name: Japanese Emperor (Daimyo) Oak (*Kashiwa*)

Type: Deciduous

Bark: Grayish brown or blackish brown



Size: Height 15-20m Where in Hokkaido: Northern & Eastern Hokkaido

Interesting Fact: Leaves can be used for cooking





Name: Japanese Poplar (Doronoki / Popura)

Type: Deciduous

Bark: Gray

Size: Height 30-40m

Where in Hokkaido: All regions

Interesting Fact: Often used as a windbreak, wood can be used for making matches, boxes or pulp







Interesting Fact: In the same tree family as birch, wood is good for smoking seafood, furniture making

Name: Alder (Hannoki)

Type: Deciduous

Bark: Purple brown

Size: Height 30m /

- Name: Siebold's Beech (Buna)
- **Type**: Deciduous **Bark:** Light gray & smooth

Size: Height 35m



Interesting Fact: Leaves turns dark green as seasons progress



Name: Acacia / Mimosa (*Akashia*)

Type: Deciduous **Bark:** Reddish brown

Size: Height 15-20m

Where in Hokkaido: Southern & Central

Interesting Fact: Plentiful white flowers in late spring with strong pleasant smell; other types have yellow flowers; over 1,200 varieties worldwide





Type: Deciduous Bark: Reddish brown

Name: Ginko (Ichou)

Size: Height 25-30m

Where in Hokkaido: Not native but commonly planted in parks & streets

Interesting Fact: Brilliant yellow-orange colors in fall; Hokkudai Univ. has a famous Ginko Avenue; nuts are edible
