Day 1: Otaru, Yoichi & Niseko

- Pick-up in Sapporo** Our guide will be waiting at the lobby of your hotel to begin the tour; **please confirm hotel details**
- Drive to Otaru** Estimated driving time is approx. 45 min.
- Otaru Sakaimachi Historical District & Otaru Canal** Visit quaint shops and dessert houses along a restored, century-old avenue of historic buildings, including LaTao Chocolate, Music Box Museum and many more, along with the nearby atmospheric canal
- Lunch in Otaru** Eat at the Sankaku Seafood Market, specializing in live seafood tanks for made-to-order cuisine, or order from the varied menu; Alternatively, try the local's Nantaru Seafood Market or another restaurant elsewhere in town

Nikka Whisky Distillery

Tour the beautiful distillery grounds and learn about the history of Hokkaido's most famous whisky brand; samples & purchases available

Scenic Drive around Niseko

Drive up a winding mountain road to the geothermally-active highland plateau behind Niseko

Yumoto Onsen & Hot Springs Lake

Take a relaxing onsen at this voluminous hot spring with numerous outdoor pools and even a mud bath

Hotel Check-in, Onsen & Dinner

Niseko is a popular winter resort surrounded by nature that is more peaceful in the summer offseason

Day 2: Kyogoku & Lake Toya

Mt. Yotei Scenic Drive

Enjoy scenic views of Mt. Yotei, known as the Mt. Fuji of the North

Kyogoku Freshwater Spring

Bring your water bottles to fill-up at this revered local spring

Lake Hill Farm & Silo Observatory

Famous gelato with great countryside views (DIY gelato making workshop available upon request; reservation required), followed by the iconic Lake Toya caldera rim viewpoint at Silo Observatory

Lake Toya Ferry & Nakajima Island

Ride the ferry on a peaceful cruise through the placid caldera lake, the deepest in Hokkaido, and alight at Nakajima Island for a nature walk

Lunch at Lake Toya

Recommended: Wakasaimo with lake views and quality Japanese cuisine

**Mt. Usu-zan
Ropeway & Crater
Rim Walk**

Ride the ropeway, then walk along the crater rim of Hokkaido's most active volcano for great views of Mt. Yotei, Mt. Showa-Shinzan, Lake Toya & the Pacific Ocean; extended hiking options available

**Kompirayama Trail
of Destruction**

The trail passes ruins where you'll see the destructive power of volcanos by observing the damage that was inflicted from the most recent eruption in 2000

**Hotel Check-in,
Onsen & Dinner**

Lake Toya is located in an active geothermal region and is one of the deepest lakes in Japan; we'll try to reserve lake view rooms from where to watch the nightly fireworks show starting at 8:45pm

Sobetsu Fruit Village

All-you-can-eat fruit picking at a pretty orchard located at the base of Mt. Usu-zan active volcano; summer berries and prunes will be in season on this day

Panoramic views of the Central Mountain Range, including Mt. Yotei, the "Fuji of the North"

**Shiraoi Upopoi
National Ainu
Museum**

This newly renovated museum & outdoor village shows the life of the Ainu - Hokkaido's indigenous people - before modern development, with daily cultural shows, Ainu crafts DIY workshops, souvenir stalls and a cafe

**Lunch at Coastal Road
Seafood Market OR
Shiraoi Wagyu Beef
Restaurant**

Choose your lunch from the live tanks or from the varied menu at this market-style restaurant, OR head to our recommended farm restaurant specializing in Shiraoi wagyu beef (please confirm your preference)

**Noboribetsu Hell
Valley & Geothermal
Sightseeing**

Explore the geothermal spots of Noboribetsu by foot or car, such as the 450m long Hell Valley, the huge Oyunuma hot springs lake, river and waterfalls, and have a foot bath in the middle of the forest

One of Japan's most important holidays, with traditional dances & neighborhood festivals held around Hokkaido



Hotel Check-in & Onsen Tokachigawa Onsen is a hot springs resort outside Obihiro famous for its medicinal waters

Overnight: Tokachigawa Onsen (breakfast included)



Day 5: Sahoro, Shikaoi & Yorkshire Farm

Hira Agricultural Farm Visit this working farm to experience harvesting potatoes, corn, tomatoes and/or other veggies in season

Sahoro Bear Mountain Safari The best bear park in Japan: see the Hokkaido brown Higuma bears roam their natural habitat as you ride the park's safari bus then walk along elevated walkways with a chance to observe a variety of wildlife

Lunch in Shintoku Have lunch at a local restaurant in Shintoku, a town famous for its soba

Fujita Dairy Farm Tour & Cow Milking Learn everything about cows and dairy production at this all-inclusive tour, try milking a cow, and lastly, enjoy a delicious ice cream from the farm

Yorkshire Farm Shepherd Activities You'll have a chance to feed lamb and watch the sheep herding performance at Hokkaido's best sheep farm

Farm Check-in & Dinner Enjoy staying on a Hokkaido sheep farm set up for tourism, with quality countryside cuisine

Overnight: Yorkshire Farm or similar (dinner & breakfast included)



Day 6: Furano, Biei, Mt. Tokachidake & Sapporo

Drive to Furano Estimated driving time is approx. 2 hrs.

Furano Cheese Factory A famous cheese factory supplying various restaurants in the region; participate in a cheese, butter, or ice cream making DIY workshop (**please notify us of your preference, prior reservation required**)

Tomita Farm Visit the most famous flower field in Hokkaido, with seasonal flowers planted throughout the green seasons - such as lavender peaking in mid to late July - and ice cream and food stands abound

Lunch in Biei Choose from a number of farm-fresh restaurants, including the Michelin-star French cuisine Asperges or its sister restaurant Bi.ble (reservations required)

Shikisai no Oka Flower Fields In these vast, spectacular flower gardens you can ride a tractor, buggy, or pet the alpaca at the mini alpaca farm (activities are self-pay)

Biei Blue Pond & Shirahige Falls Recently, the Blue Pond has become one of Hokkaido's premier sites; the nearby Shirahige Falls spill into the same milky-blue waters of the Biei River

Mt. Tokachidake Scenic Driving Road A winding mountain road in the southern reaches of Daisetsuzan National Park with a chance to spot red Hokkaido foxes, walk on the hardened lava of past eruptions, and take a wild hot springs bath at Fukiage Onsen (mixed-bathing, bathing suits permitted, but no changing facilities)
