**Drive to Mt. Tarumae** Estimated driving time is approx. 1 hr. 30 min.

#### Mt. Tarumae & Mt. Fuppushidake Hike

The trail starts at the 7<sup>th</sup> station parking lot, from where the 1 hour hike to the crater rim begins. The hiking trail is well-defined and has steps leading to the top. Once on the crater rim, we can circumnavigate the crater (2.5 hrs.), and can add the side peak of Mt. Fuppushi (2.5 hrs.) and/or head into the heart of the volcano to the steaming fumaroles and sulfur vents within (1 hr. hike)

Lake Shikotsu Promenade & Nature Center	Stroll along the shores of Hokkaido's deepest lake and one of the clearest lakes in Japan; then visit the nearby Nature Center to learn about the park's endemic flora & fauna & geologic features in a short documentary; if time permits
Marukoma Onsen	One of Hokkaido's best onsens is situated on the shores of Lake Shikotsu, with multiple outdoor baths and stunning views; last entry 3:00pm

#### Mt. Tokachidake Hike

This 5-6 hour day hike starts on the lava remains at the foot of Mt. Tokachidake, Hokkaido's deadliest volcano, and climbs gradually, then steeply up loose volcanic tuff. The moon-like summit area, with its hues of blacks and grays, as well as the unobstructed views, make this hike one of the best in Hokkaido. We'll complete the hike by returning back down the same route to the trailhead.

Biei Blue Pond & Shirahige Falls Recently, the Blue Pond has become one of Hokkaido's premier sites; the nearby Shirahige Falls spill into the same milky-blue waters of the Biei River; if time permits

Day 3: Mt. Asahidake, Asahidake Traverse & Mt. Kurodake Hut

Asahidake Ropeway & Sugatami Highland Plateau Ride the ropeway to the stunning Sugatami Highland Plateau at the foot of Mt. Asahidake, Hokkaido's highest peak, for beginner-level hiking to steaming fumaroles an stunning views

#### Mt. Asahidake to Mt. Kurodake Traverse Hike

This classic traverse over the northern part of Daisetsuzan National Park begins at the Sugatami Highland Plateau, as the trail ascends consistently up the southern ridge of Mt. Asahidake, the highest mountain in Hokkaido. After about 2.5 hours, we'll be at the peak and take a break for lunch, hopefully with sweeping views in every direction. After lunch, the trail descends into a large crater, and after following the crater rim for an hour, we'll start to emerge under the Mt. Kurodake Hut, our overnight location

Nakadake, from where we'll descend through a narrow cleft to a wild onsen, where a footbath is waiting. From there it's a further 1.5 hours back to the top ropeway station, passing numerous small ponds en route.



Take in the wide panoramic views of Japan's largest protected marshland with a lovely forest walk and a chance to spot wildlife such as the iconic Tancho cranes Akan International Crane Center Learn about the incredible history of the tancho cranes, one of the symbols of Japan, and their near extinction; outside of winter there are only a few resident cranes at the center (if time permits)
