Easy cycling along the rice paddies at Higashikawa, with the peaks of the mighty Daisetsuzan Mountain Range in the distance

#### Lunch in Higashikawa

Choose from a wide variety of small restaurants, many with original twists on classic Japanese staples including soba, udon, ramen & more

#### Drive to Biei

Estimated driving time is approx. 30 min.

#### Chiyoda Farm Cow Milking DIY

Try milking a Hostein cow at this farm located in the rolling hills of Biei, which also has a small petting zoo and a highly rated wagyu restaurant

#### Shikisai-no-Oka Flower Fields

In these vast, spectacular flower gardens you can ride a tractor, buggy, or pet the alpaca at the mini alpaca farm (activities are self-pay)

**Biei Blue Pond & Shirahige Falls**

Recently, the Blue Pond has become one of Hokkaido's premier sites; the nearby Shirahige Falls spill into the same milky-blue waters of the Biei River

**Mt. Tokachidake Scenic Driving Road**

A winding mountain road in the southern reaches of Daisetsuzan National Park with a chance to spot red Hokkaido foxes, walk on the hardened lava of past eruptions, take a wild hot springs bath at Fukiage Onsen (mixed-bathing, bathing suits permitted, but there are no changing facilities) and enjoy incredible views

**Drive to Furano**

Estimated driving time is approx. 45 min.

**Dinner in Furano**

Choose from a variety of great restaurants, including Kumagera, a fantastic izakaya famous for nabe and shabu-shabu, and even has bear meat on the menu!

**Hotel Check-in**

<b>Onuma Lake Islets Nature Walk</b>	Walk among the hundreds of islets at this small lake, which is crowned by an attractive volcano, while enjoying the fall foliage
<b>Lunch at Onuma</b>	Choose from a variety of local restaurants
<b>Drive to Hakodate</b>	Estimated driving time is approx. 30 min.
<b>Konbukan Kelp Factory</b>	Tour this seaweed factory and sample the endless variety of seaweed products
<b>Hakodate Kanemori Red Brick Warehouses</b>	Adjacent to the historic district, these old warehouses have been converted into a charming shopping plaza, with numerous cafes and restaurants
<b>Hakodate Ropeway &amp; Nightview</b>	Ride the ropeway to see the famed night views of Hakodate Bay, rated the 3 <sup>rd</sup> best night view in Japan
<b>Dinner in Hakodate</b>	Choose from a variety of great local restaurants, including seafood and wagyu recommendations



## Day 8: Lake Toya & Noboribetsu Onsen

<b>Drive to Lake Toya</b>	Estimated driving time is approx. 1 hr. 30 min.
<b>Lake Hill Farm &amp; Silo Observatory</b>	Famous gelato with great countryside views, followed by the iconic Lake Toya caldera rim viewpoint at Silo Observatory
<b>Mt. Usu-zan Ropeway &amp; Crater Rim Walk</b>	Ride the ropeway, then walk along the crater rim of Hokkaido's most active volcano for great views of Mt. Yotei, Mt. Showa-Shinzan, Lake Toya & the Pacific Ocean; extended hiking options available
<b>Lunch at Lake Toya</b>	Recommended: Wakasaimo with lake views and quality Japanese cuisine
<b>Kompirayama Trail of Destruction</b>	The trail passes ruins where you'll see the destructive power of volcanos by observing the damage that was inflicted from the most recent eruption in 2000
<b>Orofureto Mountain Pass Scenic Drive</b>	Panoramic views of the Central Mountain Range, including Mt. Yotei, the "Fuji of the North"
<b>Noboribetsu Hell Valley &amp; Geothermal Sightseeing</b>	Explore the geothermal spots of Noboribetsu by foot or car, such as the 450m long Hell Valley, the huge Oyunuma hot springs lake, river and waterfalls, and have a foot bath in the middle of the forest
<b>Drive to Sapporo</b>	Estimated driving time is approx. 1 hr. 30 min.
